

# Electoral Review of East Hampshire

The independent Local Government Boundary Commission for England is carrying out an electoral review of East Hampshire District Council.

The review will draw new council ward boundaries across East Hampshire.

The Commission has also announced that the council should have 44 councillors in future: the same as the current arrangements.

Now we are asking for evidence about your local area to help us decide a new pattern of wards for East Hampshire.
