AGENDA

1. To receive apologies for absence.
2. **Declaration of interest:** Members are reminded of their responsibility to declare any disclosable pecuniary interest which they may have in any item of business on the agenda no later than when that item is reached. Unless dispensation has been granted, you may not participate in any discussion of, or vote on, or discharge any function related to any matter in which you have a pecuniary interest as defined by regulations made by the Secretary of State under the Localism Act 2011. You must withdraw from the room or chamber when the meeting discusses and votes on the matter.
3. To open the meeting to members of the public to enable them to address questions to Parish Councillors. *The period of time which is designated for public participation shall not exceed 20 minutes. Each member of the public is entitled to speak once only in respect of business itemised on the agenda and shall not speak for more than 3 minutes. A question asked by a member of public during public participation session at a meeting shall not require a response or debate.*
4. To receive and approve the Minutes of the Grounds Committee meeting held on Monday 11 July 2022.
5. To receive a verbal update in respect of the completed projects/significant works undertaken by the Countryside Team.
6. To receive a report and quotations in respect of repairs to play equipment, and consider the way forward.
7. To receive a report and consider the quotations in respect of palisade fencing at Jubilee.
8. To consider the future maintenance of the footpaths within the Parish of Horndean.
9. To receive and consider the provision of a 'green trail loop' as a potential Community Infrastructure Levy project.
10. To note the concerns raised as to the toxic 'forever chemicals' pertaining to artificial turf.
