6. Each member of the public is entitled to speak once only in respect of business itemised on the agenda and shall not speak for more than 3 minutes. A question asked by a member of public during public participation session at a meeting shall not require a response or debate.*

9. Receipt of nomination to existing committees and election of Chairman to Committees
10. Appointment of any new committees, confirmation of the terms of reference, the number of members (including, if appropriate substitute councillors) and receipt of nominations to them.
